1 Intro

Welcome to X-Comp. This macOS app helps you turn an Xcode project into polished App Store copy, website content and a complete user manual. This guide explains how to start a session, provide project and publishing details, generate content, review the results and copy or save the finished material.

3 About this app

X-Comp is designed for app developers, product teams and marketers who need clear, accurate product writing based on an app's real features. Choose an Xcode project, provide the requested project and publishing information, select the desired AI quality, and start generation. X-Comp analyzes the project and presents copy and manual content ready for review. You can edit website fields and manual content, copy individual sections or the complete manual, and save the project or export the manual as a DOCX file.

5 Functions

5.1 Start a new X-Comp session

Launch X-Comp on macOS and choose Start a new X-Comp session. This opens a clean workspace for a new content-generation task. Use a new session when beginning work on another app or when you want to replace the current project and generated results. The main workspace provides the project-selection area, AI Quality controls, content fields and generation command. You can operate the visible controls with the mouse or trackpad and enter text with the keyboard. The documented keyboard input includes ←, →, ↑, ↓, Space, ↵ and Escape; use them to move through available controls or activate the currently focused control where macOS presents that behavior.

5.2 Choose an Xcode project

In the project area, choose Project and select the Xcode project you want X-Comp to examine. The selected project becomes the source for the generated App Store copy, website content and manual. Confirm that the project shown in the workspace is the intended product before generating. Use the mouse or trackpad to open the project chooser, navigate to the project, and select it. Keyboard navigation is also available with ↑ and ↓; press ↵ to confirm a selection and Escape to close the chooser. After selection, the project controls identify the chosen project and the workspace is ready for the remaining information.

5.3 Configure AI Quality

Use the AI Quality area to choose the quality level for generation. Select AI Quality, review the available quality choices, and choose the level appropriate for the importance and depth of the material you are preparing. The selected quality is used when X-Comp generates the product copy and manual. Choose the control with the mouse or trackpad, move through choices with ↑ or ↓, and press ↵ to confirm. Press Escape to close the choice control without making a new selection. The quality choice can be made before starting generation and reviewed in the workspace alongside the project information.

5.4 Enter the OpenAI API key

Enter the required key in the field labeled OpenAI API Key. Click or tap the field with the mouse or trackpad, then type or paste the key using the keyboard. Review the field before generating to ensure the intended key is present. Use Tab or the visible controls to move to the next field. The field is part of the current X-Comp session and is used when content generation begins. Press Escape to leave an active field or dismiss an open control; press ↵ when the surrounding form presents a confirmation action.

5.5 Generate content and the manual

After choosing a project, setting AI Quality and entering the OpenAI API Key, choose Generate Content & Manual. X-Comp analyzes the product and displays progress, including the message AI is analyzing your product. When processing finishes, the workspace presents

the generated App Store material, website content and complete user manual. Use the mouse or trackpad to activate the button. With keyboard focus, press Space or ↵ to activate it. While generation is in progress, follow the progress display until the workspace reports that the results are ready. The resulting material is organized for review and copying rather than requiring you to reconstruct the content manually.

5.6 Review generated App Store fields

After generation, review the App Store fields in the results area. Read each generated value and check that its wording accurately represents the product. Select a field with the mouse or trackpad to inspect or edit its text, then use the keyboard to make corrections. Move between controls with the available focus navigation; ↑ and ↓ can move through vertically arranged controls, while ← and → can move within horizontally arranged choices. Press ↵ when a focused control offers confirmation. Your edits remain part of the current results and can be copied with the available copy commands.

5.7 Edit website content

Open the website-content area to review the generated website paragraphs and fields. Select a paragraph or field with the mouse or trackpad and place the insertion point where wording needs adjustment. Type directly with the keyboard, select existing text and replace it, or move through the text with the arrow keys. Use ← and → for horizontal movement and ↑ and ↓ for movement between lines. When finished, click another control or press ↵ where confirmation is offered. The edited website content is then available for copying in formatted form through the website copy controls.

5.8 Review and edit the user manual

Choose the User Manual result to review the generated manual. X-Comp organizes it into chapters and function headings; the table of contents is generated automatically from those headings. Select a chapter or function section with the mouse or trackpad and read its body text. Where an editable manual area is presented, click into the text and type revisions directly. Use ←, →, ↑ and ↓ to move through text, and use Space or ↵ when a focused control requires activation. Review the title, subtitle, chapter order and function descriptions before copying or exporting the manual.

5.9 Set manual publishing details

Complete the manual fields shown with the generated manual: App title, User Manual, official download URL, helpdesk URL and Company name. Click each field with the mouse or trackpad and enter or paste the desired value with the keyboard. The App title identifies the product, while the download URL, helpdesk URL and company name supply the publishing information used in the manual output. Use Tab or the arrow keys to move between fields, ↵ to confirm a field when applicable, and Escape to leave an active entry without opening another control.

5.10 Copy the complete manual

When the manual is ready, choose the command that copies the complete manual. X-Comp places the full manual, including its title, subtitle, chapters and function sections, on the

macOS pasteboard. Use the mouse or trackpad to select the copy command, or place keyboard focus on it and press Space or ⌘. Switch to the destination application and paste normally with its paste command. This is the quickest way to transfer the finished manual into another document or publishing workflow.

5.11 Copy the manual title and subtitle

Use the copy controls beside the title and subtitle when you need only the manual's opening information. Select the title copy command to place the app title on the pasteboard, or select the subtitle copy command to copy User Manual. Activate either command with the mouse or trackpad, or focus it and press Space or ⌘. Paste the result into the destination document. These controls let you reuse the opening fields without copying the chapters and function content.

5.12 Copy a manual chapter or function section

Each manual chapter and function section can be copied separately. Locate the desired chapter or function heading, select its copy control with the mouse or trackpad, and paste the resulting text into the destination application. Keyboard focus can be used instead: press Space or ⌘ on the selected copy control. Copy individual sections when assembling a shorter document, revising one part elsewhere or sharing a specific workflow. The copied material preserves the section's readable manual content.

5.13 Save the X-Comp document

Choose Save .xcomp to save the current X-Comp session as a document. The saved document keeps the project session and its generated or edited material together for later work. Use the mouse or trackpad to select Save .xcomp, choose the destination in the macOS save dialog, provide a filename if requested, and confirm the save. Keyboard navigation in the dialog uses ↑ and ↓ to move through items, ⌘ to confirm, and Escape to cancel. Return to the saved document later with Open Content.

5.14 Open an existing X-Comp document

Choose Open Content when you want to continue work from a previously saved X-Comp document. In the macOS open dialog, locate the saved document, select it with the mouse or trackpad, and confirm the choice. Use ↑ and ↓ to move through the file list, ⌘ to open the selected document, or Escape to close the dialog. X-Comp restores the session so you can review or continue editing its generated content and manual.

5.15 Export the manual as DOCX

Choose Save DOCX from the manual results area to export the completed manual as a Microsoft Word document. Select the command with the mouse or trackpad, choose a destination in the macOS save dialog, enter a filename if requested, and confirm. Use ↑ and ↓ to navigate the dialog, ⌘ to confirm the destination, or Escape to cancel. The exported document is intended for opening, reviewing and editing in a word processor while retaining the manual's structured title, headings and body content.

5.16 Finish the current session

When you have copied or saved the required material, finish the current session using the session-completion control provided in the workspace. Use the mouse or trackpad to select it, or focus the control and press Space or ↵. Finish the session after saving any work you want to keep. To begin a different project afterward, choose Start a new X-Comp session and follow the project-selection workflow again. Press Escape to leave an active control without activating it.

5.17 New Project

When you are finished and want to open a new X-Comp project simply click on the app icon. If you prefer a second project in parallel then press ⌘+n.
